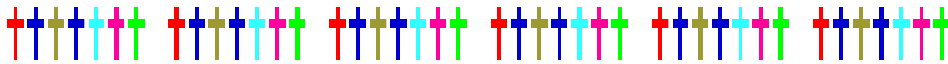
## MIDWEEK LENTEN WORSHIP

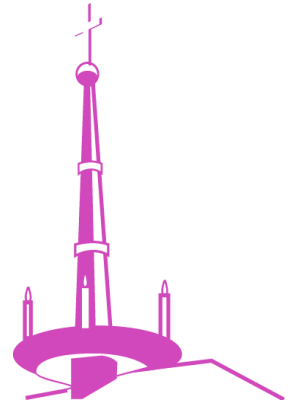

## PASTOR'S PAGE

Dear Friends,  
It is hard to believe that we are almost to Lent.

That means the annual Shrove Tuesday Dinner and Talent Show. Matt assures me that plans are well underway and, yes, I am going to MC the event again this year, so if you have any good jokes let me know.

Please consider how you approach the Lenten Season. Lent is so very important if we are to fully appreciate the Resurrection of our Lord. There can be no recognition of forgiveness if there is no recognition of Sin and so the Lenten journey is truly our journey to the cross with Christ.

Too often Lenten sacrifices seem to be no more than "New Year's resolutions." We almost expect not to keep them. But, Lenten sacrifices can and should be more. They should be daily reminders of the sacrifice Christ made for us. They should give us pause in hectic lives and motivate us to offer prayers of thankfulness. Lenten sacrifices should help us anticipate the joy of Easter.

This year I plan to give up meat (not fish) and between meal snacks for Lent. It sounds like a lot but compared to what our Lord had to give up on my account, it is nothing. Some folks actually add stuff for Lent, too. They might start walking or jogging or volunteering for a good cause. This is good, too, but I find that giving up something works as a better reminder for me. Whatever you choose to do, do it with prayer and gratitude. Make it a true sacrifice – something that is NOT easy for you.



Think of Advent's Mission Statement as your goal for Lent.

Worship God: Add mid week worship to your agenda.  
Follow Jesus: Jesus fasted for 40 days in the wilderness. Focus on Him for 40 days of Lent.  
Serve Others: Seek to do one out of the ordinary good deed each day.  
Make Disciples: Invite someone to come to worship with you.

## THE GIFT THAT KEEPS GIVING

There has been some confusion about one of the avenues of revenue for Advent.

*ADVENT YOUTH SCRIPT*, also known as, *Advent Cares*, is a means of adding extra income to the budget at Advent by purchasing various gift cards at the designated table in the Narthex. The table, located by the playground doors, has printed info and usually has someone there to help explain the program to you.

There is another option at the table as well. *Columbus Kroger Community Rewards* lets you designate a % of your Kroger bill to be returned to Advent. All you have to do is provide a skew number (available at the above table) to your check out person one time. Last year Advent received over \$1,700 from this resource. **Souper Bowl of Caring – February 7<sup>th</sup>** - Advent's youth will be collecting donations for the Souper Bowl for Caring after the morning services on **February 7<sup>th</sup>**. The youth will be standing at the doors holding pots, simply place your donation in one of these pots. ### **Lenten Services**

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday services on February 17. Beginning on February 24, Council invites you to join your Advent family on Wednesday evenings throughout Lent as we continue our tradition of a soup supper followed by a brief worship service. This is a wonderful opportunity to come together for fellowship and worship during this most meaningful season of the church year. Soup suppers begin at 6:30, the worship service begins at 7:15 and concludes at 8:00. We encourage you to attend this family-friendly service, which includes child care for those who have young children. Can't leave work in time for supper? Many folks come only for the worship service. Don't like to drive at night? Let a Council member know – we'll be happy to arrange for someone to drive you. We look forward to spending this time of preparation for the wonderful miracle of Easter together as the family of God at Advent.

### **Scrip Funds**

Your support of the Scrip program is one way that you help us to fund our activities. We thank those of you who are "Kroger shoppers" for registering with Kroger for their donation program (a percentage of your purchase total is donated to Advent) and we thank those of you who purchase gift cards, as well – it all adds up! While the original intent for Scrip funds was to support youth activities, for the past few years this income has been going to our general fund in order to help us meet our monthly expenses. At our January meeting, Council voted unanimously to begin splitting the income from the Scrip program between the general fund and the designated fund for youth activities.

### **Financials Update**

Council is happy to report that we are on much sounder financial footing as we begin the new year; November and December giving was stronger than in September and October. Your commitment to supporting Advent is appreciated. As we move forward in 2010, Council remains committed to responsible stewardship of Advent's resources.

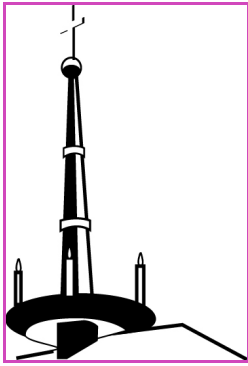

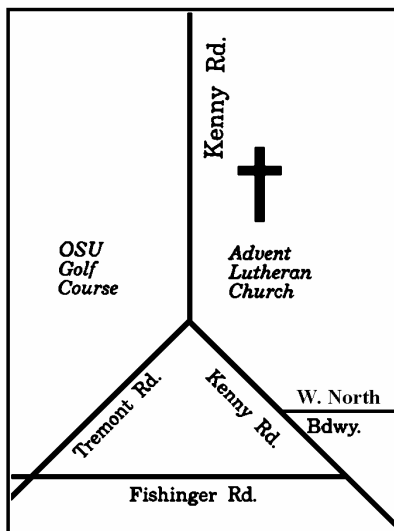
